Guest blogging on Embedded Computing Design/IoT Design is easy. There are just a few rules/guidelines

1. Topic must be of professional interest to a design engineer (cover a technology, a standard, an industry trend, etc.)
2. Blogs written in first person usually get more attention
3. The same blog can't appear on any other site
4. Company/product pitches are not allowed, but mentions are okay
5. Word count is typically 400-700, but shorter or longer is okay
6. Art is allowed but not required
